## **Spontaneous Volunteer Bush Fire Training**







## **Definitions:**

**Spontaneous Volunteers** is a non-registered volunteer who occasionally attends bushfires to assist. These volunteers are critical to the expedient response and reducing the initial spread of bushfire. Spontaneous Volunteers are often referred too as 'farmer response' and response is normally part of their business or personal sense of inclination to the community. A Spontaneous volunteer although may on occasion, does not need to attend Bush Fire Brigade meetings or attend other mandatory requirements of a Bush Fire Volunteer.

**Bush Fire Volunteers** are volunteer firefighters who actively attend and contributes to a bush fire brigade. These volunteers have minimum standards for attendance at training, meetings, and skills development. Bushfire Volunteers are critical to the effective operation of Shire supplied fire appliances. To operate a shire supplied appliance you must be a Bush Fire Brigade Volunteer.
