

Budget 2019/2020



Each year a budget is prepared for Council's consideration and approval, and once adopted, it becomes the basis of works, services and activities for the financial year.

Approval of an amount in the Budget one year, does not carry over to the next year – a new allocation must be made.

The Strategic Community Plan adopted by Council in January 2018 has 5 broad areas –

1. Community – to enhance and improve a sense of community in the Shire
2. Economic – to improve and add to local economic development and activity
3. Environment – to protect or improve the natural environment
4. Infrastructure – to maintain and add to infrastructure used by the community
5. Civic leadership – to better allocate scarce resources and effectively interact with the community
