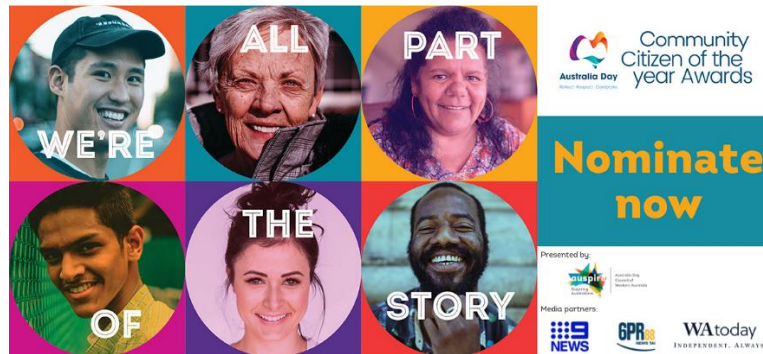

The Awards are made up of four categories:

- Community Citizen of the Year
- Young Community Citizen of the Year (under 25 years of age)
- Senior Community Citizen of the Year (over 65 years of age)
- Active Citizenship (Group or Event)

Nominations can be made for contributions to education, health, fundraising, voluntary services, business, sports, arts, the environment, social inclusion or any other area that enhances the wellbeing of the community.

In particular, we encourage people from diverse backgrounds to consider nominating, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, women, young people, those living with disabilities and people from culturally diverse backgrounds.
