**PURPOSE OF REPORT:** To advise Council of the structural engineers report.

**BACKGROUND:** Reports on this structure go back several years. Council agreed to have a Structural Engineer look at the roof trusses of the hall to see if the present trusses would take the extra load which would be imposed if a ceiling was too be fitted.

The report is attached.

Council's attention is drawn to paragraph 4, which advises that in its present form, the trusses do not comply with current Building Code of Australia requirements.

Council must also be mindful of the poor state of the public toilets.

**COMMENT:** The report specifically looked at the roof trusses and the steel stumps of the building. With the roof trusses, they are undersize, spaced too far apart and the timber used for the purlins are undersize.

The report recommends a new roof system be designed and fitted. To do this the supporting posts would either be exposed on the outside of the building, or the external cladding would have to be removed, the wall framing significantly altered (at one metre intervals) to accommodate the new posts.

The newly fitted internal cladding will need to be sacrificed and replaced.

I am in the process of obtaining estimates of new roof trusses. The labour component of the installation could only be done on a cost plus basis as it would be so intensive and expensive.

**PURPOSE OF REPORT:** To advise Council of the need for the position and to have them endorse the appointment.

**BACKGROUND:** A new ablution block has been placed at the Calingiri Caravan Park and unlike the previous buildings it is proposed that the new building remain locked and not available as public toilets. The disabled facilities at the CWA building and the hall toilets will continue to operate as public facilities in Calingiri. This proposed system is similar to the situation at the Bolgart Caravan Park where the shire employees a Bolgart town site resident as caretaker.

**COMMENT:** The new ablution block has arrived at the Calingiri Caravan Park and will be completed and ready for use by the end of June 2009. It is proposed that the ablutions and laundry facilities remain locked with a caretaker employed on the same basis as the incumbent at the Bolgart Caravan Park to meet and greet residents and be a contact person for bookings and in case of problems.

The caretaker would be responsible for meeting and greeting residents as they arrive at the park, issuing and collecting keys, collecting park fees and banking

them at the shire office, cleaning the facilities and maintaining toilet paper hand towels and other stock as required. The person would preferably be a town site resident who is available most days including weekends and public holidays with a knowledge of local attractions and facilities.

The Bolgart caretaker is paid for three hours per fortnight regardless of the hours worked which averaged over the year would seem to be correct with little or no work some weeks and several hours per day when the park is occupied. It is anticipated that the Calingiri person would be employed on the same basis.

The caravan park has become a home base for workers coming to Calingiri at various times during the year including contractors at the CBH receival site as well as visitors to the region during the wildflower season. The number of visitors to the park is expected to increase as the upgrade to the ablutions and the Calingiri Progress Associations landscaping works to beautify the park are completed.

The subsequent development in the CWA building requires eighty square metres of additional brick paving at the side of the building leading into the caravan park. This

additional brick paving would supplement the landscaping work being undertaken by the Calingiri Progress Association in the caravan park to make it more attractive for visitors now that the new ablution block has been installed. The cost of this additional paving is approximately \$5,000.

The CWA building and Caravan Park are shire owned assets that will provide a small return on the investment of ratepayer funds to this project.

The proponent of the two new business' being set up in the CWA building have asked if the brick paving could be completed before they open which will be before the next years budget therefore Council is asked to consider funding the brick paving from the infrastructure reserve now.

**PURPOSE OF REPORT:** To advise Council of the request from the Town of Kwinana to allow them to decide on appropriate action to be taken.

**BACKGROUND:** In the state budget last month Treasurer Troy Buswell announced an increase in the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Levy of 300%. The increase in the levy would be used to fund the operation of the Department of Environment and Conservation and not channelled back into waste management programs as was the original intent of the levy. Although this levy is charged and collected by metropolitan local governments at their waste sites on behalf of the state government there was no consultation with local governments or WALGA.

**COMMENT:** The Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Levy is not imposed by non metropolitan local governments therefore it does have a direct impact on the Shire of Victoria Plains, however the proceeds of the levy are being used to fund many of the initiatives of the "zero waste to landfill by 2020" program. The additional \$33m collected from the increase is going to fund the DEC and by coincidence happens to be the same amount as was cut from their budget under the state governments 3% efficiency drive. The WALGA President and senior staff met with Environment Minister, Hon Donna Faragher MLC last week and she did not rule out extending the levy to non metropolitan local governments.

This shire has benefitted from the levy by the funding received for the Strategic Waste Management Plan stage 1 in the amount of \$5,000 and also through the CMVROC by \$75,000 for stage 2 of the Strategic Waste Management Plan and Regional Investment Plan (RIP) funding of \$35,400. The RIP funding is being used to employ a consultant to undertake studies on the development of a regional waste site in the CMVROC.

The Town of Kwinana is asking all local governments to join it by adopting a position based on the following dot points;

- Reject this proposed levy increase;
- Object to the use of additional funds raised by this levy to offset State Government administrative costs;
- Object to the use of this levy to do anything other than to provide resources to fund projects for advancing waste reduction and recycling; and
- Request the State Government to reconsider its position, and to meet with the Western Australian Local Government Association to resolve this matter.

WALGA advises that a number of local governments have already passed resolutions condemning the increase and the lack of consultation.

With unmanned unfenced landfill sites any increase in illegal dumping could bring forward the need for a new tip site considerably at a time when local sites are nearing capacity and a regional site is still some time off. There would be economic and environmental costs in finding alternatives while waiting for the regional site to open.

Any illegal dumping that fills our tip sites before the opening of a regional site would have a severe financial implication to the shire.

- 1. The Shire of Victoria Plains strongly condemns the use of landfill levy funds for consolidated revenue purposes and requests that the state government reconsider this position;
- 2. The Shire of Victoria Plains recognises that this increase will assist with driving greater diversion of waste from landfill, however without the infrastructure or cost support for alternative waste processing systems, the impact of the increased landfill levy will be nullified;
- 3. The Shire of Victoria Plains strongly supports that all funds raised by the landfill levy generated from domestic municipal waste streams and local governments be hypothecated back to local government to support recycling and resource recovery activities and the associated infrastructure. Without this support continued diversion of waste from landfill will be put in jeopardy as the levy increase also penalises resource recovery facilities;
- 4. The Shire of Victoria Plains strongly rejects any move to introduce the levy to non metropolitan waste sites unless appropriate funding is provided to facilitate the collection of the levy;
