The Water Corporation proposes to spread lime amended Biosolids (LAB) from Subiaco Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) to two paddocks at Wourie Pool Farm known as "Below Bobs Paddock" and "Rodgers Chains Paddock". A sorghum crop will be sown over the paddocks in September. The application rate will be 7 dry tonnes per hectare.

The review of Environmental Factors document proposes that the LAB will be spread and incorporated within seven days of delivery. That timeline will preclude fly breeding.

#### Background

On the 1<sup>st</sup> April 1992 the Health Act (Public Building Regulations) 1992 were devolved to Local Governments. Under the regulations Council has obligations to ensure that all materials, fittings, seating, appliances and other things installed or used in a public building are maintained in a proper state of repair". (Reg 21).

Advice has been received from the Department of Health on the priorities associated with upgrading work necessary in order that use of the Mogumber hall may continue.

The DoH role in public building use is to ensure that safety issues are addressed as a first priority.

#### Comment

Some safety issues that have been identified in the DoH advice are programmed to be attended to in the 2005/2006 municipal budget, they are:-

- Upgrade electrical installation and install illuminated exit signs and emergency lighting;
- Structural assessment of steel roof trusses, bracing and steel stumps;
- ▶ Replace steps on the north elevation with a compliant landing;

A number of other issues identified in the advice have already been attended to, they are:-

- ▶ The skillion section roof sheeting has been replaced and an insulated ceiling installed;
- ▶ The timber window frames have been replaced with aluminium window frames;
- ▶ The kitchen is currently being upgraded;

The remaining items identified in the DoH advice will be attended to in subsequent municipal budgets, they are:-

- Repair roof leaks/replace defective roof sheets;
- ▶ Remove internal masonite wall linings (Fire risk not in compliance with the Building Code of Aust) and replace with non-combustible wall linings 340m²;
- Provide access for the disabled:
- Repair wall cracks to ablutions
