3 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES

3.1 *Confirmation*

The Plant and Works Committee Minutes from August 2003 were confirmed at the September Ordinary Meeting of Council by Resolution 335/03.

4.1 Chief Executive Officer's Report

The Chief Executive Officer presented a verbal report to the meeting. All issues will be covered at the Ordinary Meeting.

4.2 Works Manager's Report

Construction Projects

AgLime Route 2 - Calingiri New Norcia Road

This project will take priority over all other works. Gordon Wood will control this job until completion. Gravel re-work and conditioning-water binding have progressed on the 4.30 kms of last years work from the end of bitumen near Reservoir Hill to Fletchers Brook. Once the base course has been prepared and water bound and tested for strength this will have a primer seal applied to 7m in width.

The section from Fletchers Brook to the Carani T junction will have more gravel carted for the new base coarse levels, tying into the new road alignment and will also incorporate the curve through the Mission property. The gravel will be carted from Howard's pit near Yenart T junction which is close to the job to be completed. The allocation of monies initially for 2003/04 was \$500,000; we have since been allocated another \$500,000, which brings the total for 2003/04 to \$1,000,000.

This extra money will allow us to complete an additional 5.50 kms of total reconstruction and primer seal to 7m. Including this work there will be some monies available for sealing 4.30km on Calingiri New Norcia Road (last years work) from Howard Road towards Calingiri townsite. An additional 3.30 km of seal work on the Calingiri Goomalling Road, 1.30 km near Slaters primer sealed last year, and the other section from Behanging Road just short of Benaring Road, this section was constructed and primer sealed to 7m around 4 years ago. This will complete this particular length of road totally and will not require any more treatment for approximately 12 years.

AgLime Route 2

Calingiri Goomalling Road

2.50 km total reconstruction and primer seal east of existing bitumen starting near Edmonds property.

I will be engaging a Contractor who will supply a full crew to carry out this work, they will complete the project from start to finish, and this will allow our staff to continue on with the other two large projects, without having to move machinery and staff from one end of the Shire to the other.

The Contractor (Gingin Grading Contractors) is a reputable business and has completed some of Councils Capital Works in last years programme. I was very pleased with their effort last year

and highly recommend him to carry out these works to a professional standard in readiness for the Primer Seal to be applied.

Bob King will supply the material for this project. The materials have not been tested at this stage. This will be carried out as soon as possible.

Roads to Recovery - Blackspot

Gillingarra New Norcia Road

Work has progressed on tree lopping and drainage, cleaning up on the 8km between the two bitumen sections on this road. Gravel carting will commence on the Blackspot section on 14th October the material will be carted from two locations; Edwards pit and Menzies pit. The gravel for this project has been crushed at both locations at a cost of \$3.50m³ we require 14,400m³ for this section. Drainage work will continue with a contractor to extend Headwalls and Culverts as required to allow for the additional material height. Once the drainage work is complete the contractor will continue on with additional drainage work on the AgLime projects including the Calingiri Goomalling section to be completed this financial year.

Maintenance

Toodyay Bindi Bindi Road

I have met with Railway representatives in relation to the railway crossing near Murray Riddick's and have reached an agreement with them to carry out repairs to repair the large dip on the southern side of the crossing. They are prepared to supply flagmen and locate all the services for the crossing and carry out some drainage works for the project in addition to Councils work This work is planned for the 16th October.

Maintenance

Parks and Gardens – Townsite Maintenance

Staff have been busy with mowing and spraying within all townsites. This will be ongoing to keep the areas looking neat and tidy and will also reduce the fire risks. They have also completed reticulation works on parks and reserves in readiness for the summer. This includes checking and overhauling watering systems, bores, pumps etc for the Calingiri Oval.

The main water pump at the Calingiri oval required a full service this year, bearings, seals etc. This has been fixed and refitted over the last couple of weeks at an approximate cost of \$800 this will ensure the pump works efficiently over the summer months ahead.

Cat 936 Loader

This machine has had work done on the transmission, oil leaks, and all new seals and "O" rings replaced throughout the transmission while the machine was split in half. Repairs to bucket auto leveller, starter motor and is now ready for work. The work has been completed by Terry Brooking at VP Mechanical, unfortunately with all second-hand machinery there are some parts that do need replacing, however the cost of all this work appears to be within budget.

Maintenance Grading

Some grading has been done over the past couple of weeks, however the materials are drying out very quickly and this is making it difficult to achieve good results without a water truck, and I don't believe that this is economical at this point in time. Grading will come to a halt very soon, because of the above. This is to let Council know what our proposals are so that if you receive complaints they can be dealt with on their merits.

Tenders were called for a 2 year period for the supply of Bitumen for Reseals and Primer Seal Projects. Tenders closed on Friday the 10th October 2003.

Background

Midland Brick wish to remove approximately 1000 tonnes of clay from Mr A J Clarke's property. This equates to 24 truck and dog loads and it is expected to complete the task within three working days. It is not intended to excavate any material but to remove clay stockpile. They wish to complete the task by 1st November 2003.

Approval is sought to use Behanging South Road, Erickson Road and Blood Road to enter Mr Clarke's property.

Comment

The clay is being consumed in the manufacture of high temperature refactory products and anticipated use is about 50 tonnes per month. Annually 500 – 700 tonnes. It is intended to submit an application for an Extractive Industries License to Council early next year as stockpiles have been utilised.

Under our policy we would not have objections to the proposal for the purpose of removing the stockpile. It may well be that we consider road maintenance requirements when the extractive licence is sought.
