# **Background**

John Watson-Bates has submitted a claim for a pay increase based on the increased technical and administrative role of the position including the responsibility for the computer program ROMAN 4, increased responsibilities in Depot Management and assistance to the Works Manager.

Currently under the EBA he is on Level 4 which provides an all up base rate of \$37,110.92 per annum. The majority of the Works crew are on Level 4 with Gordon Wood as leading hand on Level 5 \$38,943.40 and Ian Osboine as Works Foreman on Level 6 \$41,059.58.

# Comment

I appreciate that the responsibilities of the position have increased as John has been involved in more positions of responsibility such as the ROMANS, and ordering of materials, invoice checking etc.

The request for an increase is therefore supported. The levels are 4 (a) \$38,240.36, Level 5, \$38,943.40 and Level 6, \$41,059.58 per annum.
